Facility Pool Rules

- 1. All patrons must shower before entering the pool.
- 2. Smoking is not allowed inside pool facility.
- 3. No alcohol is permitted. Anyone under the influence of alcohol while on the premises will be asked to leave.
- 4. Chewing gum or tobacco is not allowed.
- 5. Proper swimwear is always required. Cut-offs are not allowed.
- 6. The City of Le Sueur Aqua Valley Pool is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please secure all valuables in lockers.
- 7. Lost and found items will be kept on the premises for one week. After this time, any lost and found articles will become the property of the City of Le Sueur and will be disposed of at their discretion.
- 8. Lockers are provided for storing of property. Provide your own lock; if left on overnight, pool staff will have it removed.
- 9. No running, pushing, dunking, or throwing objects in or around pool is allowed.
- 10. All jewelry, Band-Aids, and watches should be removed before swimming.
- 11. Report any broken equipment, accident, or injury to pool staff immediately.
- 12. U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets are permitted. All other personal flotation devices are NOT permitted. (*Examples: water wings, inflatable rings, etc.*).
- 13. Obscene or profane language, gestures, horseplay, or abusive behavior will not be allowed.
- 14. If any patron is posing a danger to him/herself, to others or distracting the pool staff from doing their duty, they will be immediately suspended from the facility.
- 15. Lifejackets may NOT be worn on the diving board or slide.
- 16. A patron wearing a t-shirt in the pool may only utilize sections of the pool where the water depth is below his or her armpits.
- 17. Swimming/Diving masks, fins and snorkel use are NOT permitted during open swim times.
- 18. Any toy considered by staff not to be safe is not allowed in the pool. Age appropriate/safe toys are allowed in the toddler pool. **Noodles, balls, and other toys provided at the facility are allowed in designed, specific areas.*
- 19. The use of BBQ grills is not permitted inside of the pool facility.
- 20. No bicycles, skateboards, in-line skates or other wheeled devices may be used in the pool area (Infant/Child strollers are permitted).
- 21. Patrons failing to leave the facility when asked will result in the police being called on to assist with removal.
- 22. No hanging on the ropes.
- 23. No flips, twists, or backwards jumps off the side of the pool.
- 24. The wading pool is limited to age-appropriate patrons. 6yrs and under and must be always accompanied by an adult.
- 25. Additional rules may be established and enforced as necessary to protect the health, safety and/or pleasure of the patrons utilizing the facility.

Diving Board Rules

- 1. Always Obey Lifeguards.
- 2. One diver on the board at a time.
- 3. Only one jump on the board is permitted.
- 4. Dive/jump straight off the board; do NOT dive/jump to the side.
- 5. No sitting or hanging on diving board.
- 6. No swimming under diving board. Divers must swim directly to their left and exit the pool.
- 7. Life Jackets are NOT permitted on the diving board.
- 8. You must be able to swim one width of the pool to use the diving board.

9. Failure to abide by these rules will result in loss of diving board use and/or removal from the facility.

Waterslide Rules

- 1. Feet first down the slide. No spinning or twisting.
- 2. Lifejackets are not permitted to be worn on the waterslide.
- 3. Goggles are not permitted to be worn on the waterslide
- 4. Patrons must be at least 48 inches tall and be able to swim one length of the pool to use the waterslide.
- 5. One person down the slide at a time.
