- Campsites at River Park may be reserved for a fee of \$30.00 per night by stopping at the Le Sueur Community Center (821 East Ferry Street) between the hours of 7:30am 4:00pm Monday Thursday and 7:30am 12:30pm on Fridays or via the City of Le Sueur website (www.cityoflesueur.com). Campsites may be reserved from Memorial Day weekend through fall park shutdown. Reservations will be honored in the order they are received. Reservations will be taken beginning January 1st of each year. Standing reservations for yearly camping will not be accepted.
- Check-in is at noon and check-out is at 11:00am. Camping permits are to be posted in front of your site.
- All campers must be registered, and campsite fees paid before occupying a site. A campsite's occupancy is limited to one (1) tent. Additional tents/persons are permitted only with prior approval.
- Camping is allowed only in designated sites. There are six (6) tent sites.
- A person/group may not camp for more than seven (7) days in succession without prior approval.
- Park hours are 7:00am to 10:00pm. Only registered campers are allowed from 10:00pm to 7:00am. Quiet hours are from 10:00pm to 8:00am. Excessive noise may be considered unlawful assembly and/or disturbing the peace.
- Pets are to be on a leash at all times. Pets must have current rabies vaccination. Owners are responsible for cleaning up pet waste.
- Portable stoves and grills are permitted. Fires are only allowed within fire rings and following state regulations. Do not leave a fire unattended. Ensure fires are completely extinguished before leaving. Harvesting of firewood is prohibited.
- If picnic tables are removed from or placed in shelters by user groups, they must be replaced in their original positions following the event. Tables cannot be moved from park to park.
- Vehicles are only permitted in properly marked stalls and lots. Speed limit within the park is 10 mph. Vehicles (including motorbikes) are not allowed on trails.
- Any other regulations as stated in the City of Le Sueur City Code governing and regulating the use of parks and not stated here will be enforced.
